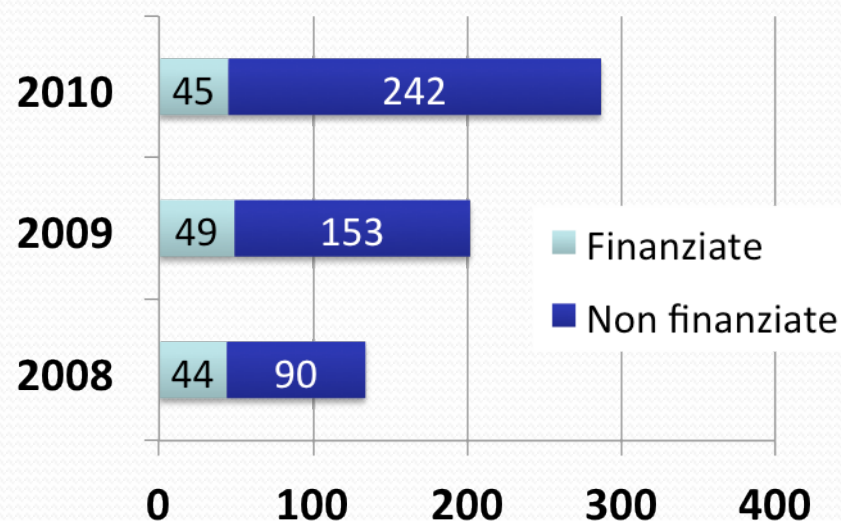

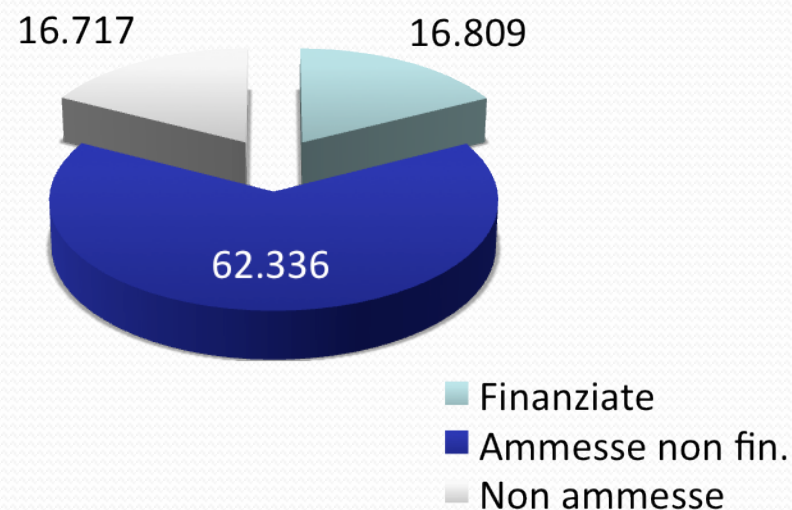
Ottenere il finanziamento non è facile

- Il tasso di successo medio è stato del 20% per i progetti del VII PQ e del 22% per i progetti CIP.

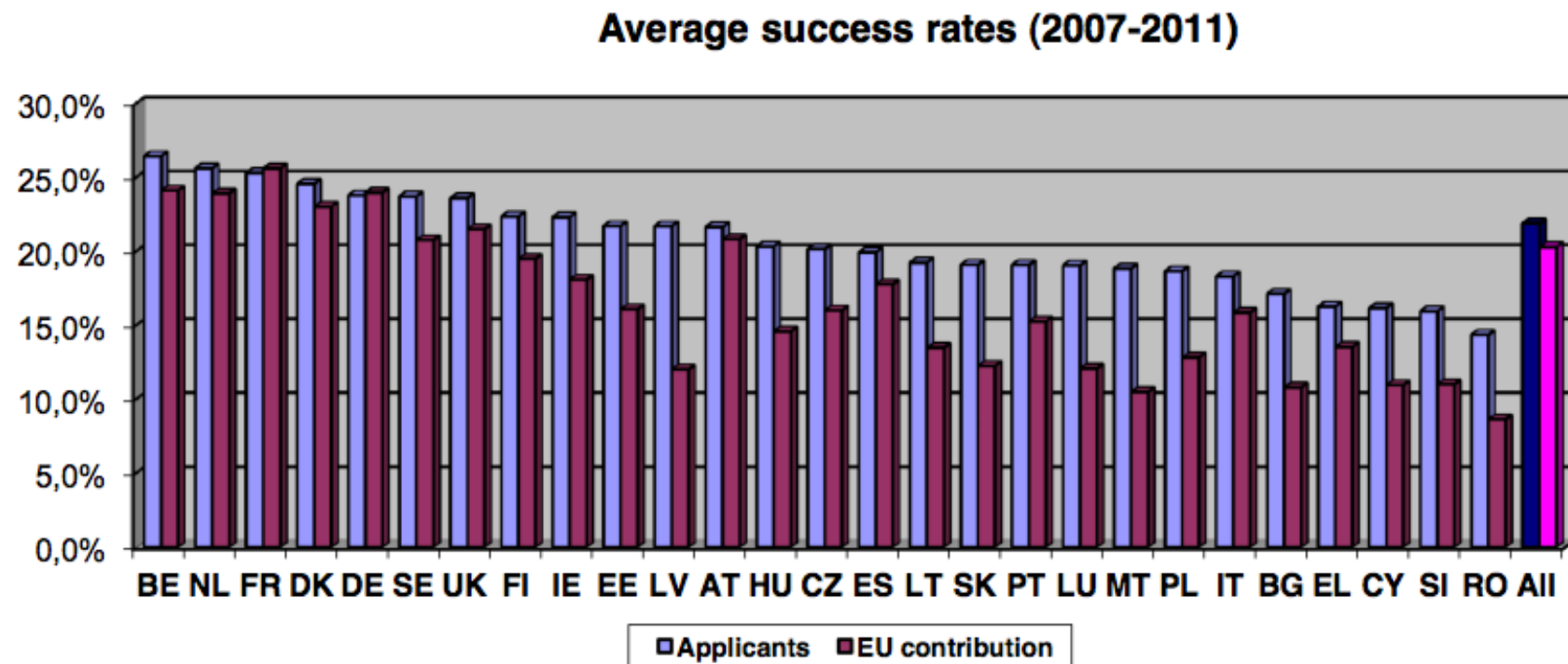
Eco-Innovation 2008-2010



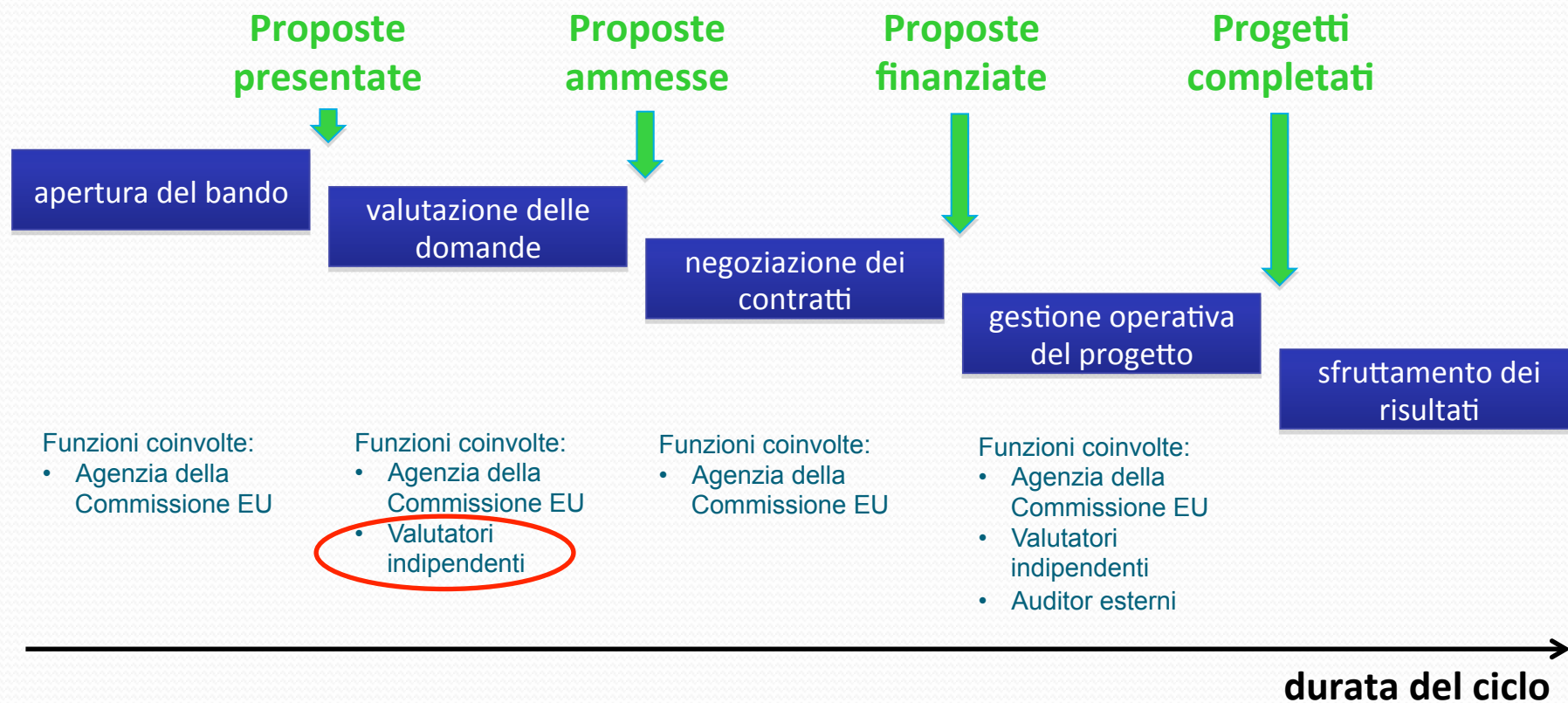
VII P.Q. 2007-2011

Excellence	• Clarity and pertinence of the objectives • Credibility of the proposed approach • Soundness of the concept, including trans -disciplinary considerations, where relevant • Extent that proposed work is ambitious, has innovation potential and is beyond the state of the art (e.g. ground-breaking objectives, novel concepts & approaches)	3/5
2. Impact	• The expected impacts listed in the work programme under the relevant topic • Enhancing innovation capacity and integration of new knowledge • Strengthening the competitiveness and growth of companies by developing innovations meeting the needs of European and global markets and, where relevant, by delivering such innovations to the markets • Any other environmental and socially important impacts • Effectiveness of the proposed measures to exploit and disseminate the project results (including management of IPR), to communicate the project and to manage research data where relevant	3/5
3. Quality & efficiency of the implementation	• Coherence and effectiveness of the work plan, including appropriateness of the allocation of tasks and resources • Complementarity of the participants within the consortium (when relevant) • Appropriateness of the management structures and procedures, including risk and innovation management	3/5

- Per tutti i bandi il **peso** dei tre criteri **è uguale a 1**
- Per il bando **PMI** il criterio **Impact ha peso 1,5**
- Per tutti i bandi la **soglia minima di punteggio è 10 (su 15)**
- Per i bandi che prevedono **due stadi**, nel primo vengono valutati solo i criteri Eccellenza e Impatto, ciascuno con soglia 4
- Per il bando **PMI** la **soglia minima è 13 in Fase 1 e 12 in Fase 2**
- In casi particolari di ex-aequo viene data **priorità** alla domanda con il punteggio più elevato sul **criterio Eccellenza**, **tranne** nel bando **PMI** in cui viene data priorità al **criterio Impatto**
